

PAINT THE TOWN Exhibit/Sale, St. Michaels Library, July 1-31

Each June, the St. Michaels Art League, in partnership with the Town government and its business owners, celebrates and supports the arts in St. Michaels by sponsoring “Paint the Town.” This is very much a community event in which all artists, 13 years of age or older are invited to literally “paint the town” – scenes of storefronts, houses, people, gardens, the waterfront, etc. In addition to competitions and prizes presented during the Paint the Town event held on Father’s Day weekend, there is also a judged art exhibit and sale of all the work created for PTT at the St. Michaels Library Gallery during the month of July. This year the exhibit will open Thursday, July 1st with a reception and awards presentation beginning at 5:30pm. In addition to cash awards for the judge’s selections, a cash award will also be presented for the “Commissioner’s Award” as the painting that “best captures the spirit of St. Michaels.” The first 40 paintings registered will be eligible to participate in this exhibit.
